Performing Art, Artwork & Exhibits - in person at Acton Methodist Church 3433 Fall Creek Hwy. on either **2/23/25 from 3-5 pm** or **2/24/25 from 5-7pm.**

ALL ENTRIES: Must complete one Registration Form per Entry: <https://bit.ly/2025SHF> - (case sensitive). **Limit of 2 entries per year in different categories.**

AWARDS Reception and Ceremony will be held at Acton Methodist Church on Friday, February 28th, starting at 5:00 pm. All entries will be available to view and vote for People's Choice Award from 5:00-6:15 pm. The Awards Ceremony will begin at 6:30 pm.

All Entries **MUST** be picked up by the end of the awards ceremony on February 28th at Acton Methodist Church. All entries not picked up will be discarded.

Rules For Entry

ALL CATEGORIES:

- ★ Complete ONE [Registration Form](#) For Each Entry: (case sensitive)
- ★ Must relate to the 2025 Student Texas History Fair theme “Rights & Responsibilities in Texas History”
- ★ Limit of 2 Entries per year in different categories

Research Paper:

- ★ Must work alone
- ★ Must be original, factual and historically based
- ★ Must be typed and double-spaced
- ★ Word count: less than 1,000 words, provided on cover sheet
- ★ Must provide a list of sources
- ★ Submitted electronically (**PDF only**) on Registration Form, e-mail or mail by **2/14/25**

Creative Writing Paper:

- ★ Must work alone
- ★ Must be original, factual and historically based.
- ★ Must be typed and double-spaced
- ★ Word count: less than 1,000 words, provided on cover
- ★ Must provide a list of sources
- ★ Submitted electronically (**PDF only**) on Registration Form, e-mail or mail by **2/14/25**

Exhibits:

- ★ Work alone or in a group (5 people or less)
- ★ Exhibit size – no larger than 40” wide, 30” deep, and 6’ high.
- ★ Include any combination of photos, research paper, artwork, 3-D models, etc.
- ★ Submitted in-person **2/23/25 from 3-5 pm** or **2/24/25 from 5-7 pm**

Artwork:

- ★ Work alone or in a group (5 people or less)
- ★ Entries can include any painting/print style, sculpture, photography, or any other art form.
- ★ Must be mounted to hang or stable enough to display
- ★ Submitted in-person **2/23/25 from 3-5 pm** or **2/24/25 from 5-7 pm**

Performing Arts:

- ★ Work alone or in a group
- ★ May include ballads, scenes, duets, solo, choirs, etc.
- ★ Must be 10 minutes or less and memorized
- ★ Performed in-person **2/23/25 from 3-5 pm** or **2/24/25 from 5-7 pm - By Appointment ONLY**

Criteria for Judging

- 2. Relates to 2025 Student History Fair theme “Rights & Responsibilities in Texas History”**

- 4. Creativity and Uniqueness of the subject matter**

- 6. Grammar, Punctuation, and Spelling (if applicable)**
